



Summer School Policies

Summer school offers students the opportunity to grow as learners, as they remediate courses they may have failed or just need more opportunities for additional practice and learning experiences. This program will result in a greater academic experience as students progress through EEACS.

Course Offerings

High School - credit recovery (for those students who have failed a core content course)

Note - course offerings may vary on a yearly basis dependent on student enrollment and need.

Middle and Elementary School

Students at this level will be offered remediation in reading and math.

Registration Process

- . 1) Complete the Summer School Enrollment form.
- . 2) Return the form, along with payment.
- . 3) Registration for Summer School closes on the last day of June.

Attendance Procedures

Because Summer School is a condensed curriculum students are required to attend everyday for the maximum benefit.

High School: Students MUST attend every day. High school course being offered are for graduation requirements, so failure to attend will result in the student not receiving the required credit. Students will be permitted 1 absence, which must have a note from the parent/guardian within 3 days of the absence. Any further absences from Summer School will result in the student not receiving credit for the course and no refund will be offered. A total of 3 late arrivals will result in 1 absence.

Middle and Elementary School: Students are to attend everyday for the maximum benefit of remediation. Failure to attend will result in students not obtaining critical skills for later success in school. If students have 3 absences they may be asked to leave the summer school program without a refund. Furthermore, a retention meeting may possibly be requested.

Student Conduct

Even though this is Summer School and the building will not be filled with the full student population, all standard codes of conduct and norms will be upheld.

Uniforms

Students will not be required to wear their school uniform, but must refrain from wearing clothing with profanity, discrimination, or anything that may be considered inappropriate for a school setting.

Students may wear shorts. Students are encouraged to bring sweatshirts or sweaters as the temperature in the building does remain cold.

Breakfast and Lunch

Breakfast and lunch will be provided on each day. Breakfast will be from 7:45-8:00am and lunch will be served at 11:45am before dismissal.

Students who arrive late or leave early may forfeit their time for breakfast or lunch.

Program Completion

After students have completed their summer school program a certificate of completion will be awarded. Teachers will communicate with parents on an as-needed basis. If there is an academic or behavioral concern with a student that may impact the completion of the program, the teacher will contact the parent immediately.
